Louisiana House: 2013 Legislative Session

1. THE LOUISIANA HAS FAITH IN FAMILIES ACT

SB 220—Walsworth (R-W. Monroe) and Ward (R-Port Allen) [Final Passage]

Provides assistance for parents who adopt children in the DCFS Foster Care program and expedites the adoption process.

86=Yes(+) 4=No(-) 15=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

2. NO TELE-MED ABORTIONS

SB 90—Mills (R-New Iberia) [Final Passage]

Requires that a person performing abortions must be licensed as an OB/GYN in Louisiana. Also prohibits "Tele-Med" chemical abortions.

99=Yes(+) 3=No(-) 3=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

3. ABORTION/CHILD ABUSE

HB 278—Hodges (R-Denham Springs) [Final Passage]

Adds coercion of a female child to undergo an abortion as a defined form of child abuse.

93=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 12=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

4. PLANNED PARENTHOOD INVESTIGATION

HR 105—Hoffmann (R-W Monroe) [Final Passage]

Requests various state and local entities to investigate and monitor Planned Parenthood construction and operation of abortion facility in Louisiana.

92=Yes(+) 5=No(-) 8=Absent(a)

Status: Sent to the Secretary of State (Governor's signature not required)

5. COMMERCIAL CONTRACTS FOR PREGNANCY

SB 162—G. Smith (D-Norco) [Concurrence on Conference Committee Report]

Provides for the creation of gestational surrogacy contracts in Louisiana.

85=Yes(-) 12=No(+) 8=Absent(a)

Status: Vetoed by the Governor

6. HUMAN TRAFFICKING HOTLINE

HB 126—Hodges(R-Denham Springs) [Final Passage]

Technical changes to the law requiring National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline information to be posted in sexually oriented businesses, truck stops, and rest stops.

95=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 10=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

7. EAST BATON ROUGE SCHOOL DISTRICT

SB 199—White (R-Baton Rouge) [Final Passage]

Creates the East Baton Rouge School District.

57=Yes(+) 36=No(-) 12=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor (Funding mechanism-SB73- failed in a separate vote.)

8. CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS

HB 8—J. Thompson (R-Bossier City) [Final Passage]

Prohibits release of information on concealed handgun permits.

76=Yes(+) 18=No(-) 11=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

9. VOTER REGISTRATION AT GUN SHOPS

SB 178—Riser (R-Columbia) [Final Passage]

Make voter registration forms available at retail establishments selling firearms.

88=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 17=Absent(a)

Status: Signed by the Governor

10. MEDICAID EXPANSION

HB 233—P. Smith (D-Baton Rouge) [Final Passage]

Implementation of President Obama's health care plan in Louisiana.

37=Yes(-) 59=No(+) 9=Absent(a)

Status: Failed on the house floor
