Provides for the creation of gestational surrogacy contracts in Louisiana. 32=Yes(-) 3=No(+) 4=Absent(a) \*\*Senate Journal, 05/30/2013, intended Status: Vetoed by the Governor to vote NAY.

#### 5. SAFE HARBOR FOR HUMAN TRAFFICKING VICTIMS

SB 88-Broome (R-Baton Rouge) [Final Passage]

Provides extra protection for children who are the victims of sex trafficking.
