Explanation of Information

LFF utilizes the official voting records of the Louisiana Legislature. In the *House*, members are allowed to change their votes in the Official Record. In *Senate*, members are allowed to change their votes. However, "on a debatable question each member shall be allowed to explain his vote in writing only, and this explanation shall be incorporated in the Journal, if requested." (Senate Rule 12.1 B)

- The Louisiana Has Faith in Families Act**
SB 220—Walsworth (R-W. Monroe) and Ward (R-Port Allen)
[Final Passage]
Provides assistance for parents who adopt children in the DCFS Foster Care program and expedites the adoption process.
36=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 3=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor
- NO TELE-MED ABORTIONS**
SB 90—Mills (R-New Iberia) [Final Passage]
Requires that a person performing abortions must be licensed as an OB/GYN in Louisiana. Also prohibits "Tele-Med" chemical abortions.
32=Yes(+) 2=No(-) 5=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor
- PLANNED PARENTHOOD INVESTIGATION**
SCR 57—Martiny (R-Kenner) [Final Passage]
Requests various state and local entities to investigate and monitor Planned Parenthood construction and operation of abortion facility in Louisiana.
31=Yes(+) 6=No(-) 2=Absent(a)
Status: Sent to the Secretary of State (Governor's signature not required)
- COMMERCIAL CONTRACTS FOR PREGNANCY**
SB 162—G. Smith (D-Norco) [Concurrence on Conference Committee Report]
Provides for the creation of gestational surrogacy contracts in Louisiana.
32=Yes(-) 3=No(+) 4=Absent(a) **Senate Journal, 05/30/2013, intended to vote NAY.
Status: Vetoed by the Governor
- SAFE HARBOR FOR HUMAN TRAFFICKING VICTIMS**
SB 88—Broome (R-Baton Rouge) [Final Passage]
Provides extra protection for children who are the victims of sex trafficking.
38=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 1=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor
- EAST BATON ROUGE SCHOOL DISTRICT**
SB 199—White (R-Baton Rouge) [Final Passage]
Creates East Baton Rouge School District.
25=Yes(+) 12=No(-) 2=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor (Funding mechanism-SB73-failed in a separate vote.)
- CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS**
HB 8—J. Thompson (R-Bossier City) [Final Passage]
Prohibits release of info on concealed handgun permits.
33=Yes(+) 2=No(-) 4=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor
- VOTER REGISTRATION AT GUN SHOPS**
SB 178—Riser (R-Columbia) [Final Passage]
Make voter registration forms available at retail establishments selling firearms.
33=Yes(+) 0=No(-) 6=Absent(a)
Status: Signed by the Governor
